I met Ace Bailey through Barbara Hartz. I knew I had to meet her when Barbara insisted in opening the Mission on Saturday mornings, rain or shine, especially the second Saturdays of the month. This is the day Ace Bailey fills a trolley with art enthusiasts and takes them on an art gallery tour around Old Town Scottsdale that she begins at the Old Adobe Mission. When Ace enters the Mission, her enthusiasm and energy permeates throughout the place. Her knowledge about the Scottsdale art scene is vast. In a quote from the *Experience Scottsdale* magazine she explains, "I want to demystify the arts. I want people to look at a piece and say, 'You know, I don't get it, but I can appreciate the work that went into it.'" She was the one who

taught Jim Seward, Judy Kenney and me about the cochineal bugs that produce the world-renowned carmine red dye that grows in our prickly pear cactus at the front of the Mission. Her Native American artists and artist friends have been using the dye for generations.

Ace is the president of Ultimate Art & Culture Tours. She offers personalized tours of the Scottsdale art, historical and architectural scene. One of her most popular tours is the Architectural Tour of the Valley Ho Hotel. As a fan of historical properties, she encourages those of us who work at the Mission the second Saturdays of the month to talk about the history of the Mission. She states, "When I lead tours, I want people to
